He is the author/co-author of 14 books, including Comparative International Accounting (2008), The Economics of Taxation (latest edition 2007), An International Introduction to Financial Accounting (2007), Pocket Accounting (fourth edition, 2001), The Convergence Handbook (2000), and International Guide to Interpreting Company Accounts (second edition, 1999).

Dr Nobes is a member of the ICAEW Financial Reporting Committee and vice-chairman of the accounting working group of the Fédération des Experts Comptables Européens, advising the EC Commission.
